NOTE FROM NURSE JEN- A Note on the Norovirus:

I wanted to send some information about the Norovirus that has been on the increase lately. This is the highly contagious gastrointestinal virus that causes vomiting and diarrhea. As always, we will be closely following the wellness policy that states a student is to remain home from school until they have been free from vomiting, diarrhea and fever (without fever reducing medication) for at least 24 hours. For this virus, alcohol based hand sanitizer is not effective. Handwashing using proper technique is especially important right now to help prevent the spread of this virus.
